WHS(Mines)R 2022 Awareness Training

With the new Work Health & Safety Act 2020 and Regulations coming into effect on 31 March 2022, Pythagorisk Pty Ltd (PRPL) are pleased to offer a transition pathway to this new WHS legislative regime.

Our staged approach: We starting with the WHS Act Awareness Training in February-March 2022 (available soon both on-line or in-house training), now we are up to Stage 2 which involves the *WHS(Mines)R 2022 Awareness Training* which takes place in April-May 2022. The final Stage 3 of our approach is to prepare Statutory Position candidates to undertake relevant online DMIRS examinations. Stage 3 is expected to take place during the June-August period depending on the actual examination arrangements and dates.

The Facilitator: Our Director, Trevor N Little has a First Class Mine Manager's certificate in SA and WA, and has had experience in preparing candidates for Statutory certificates for over twenty years. He also developed the first MSIA s44 training course in 2005, and has been exposed to six different legislative regimes in his career; one in NSW, one in SA, one in PNG, and the WHS Act will be his third in WA.

Topics covered: Preliminaries; Key terms and definitions; Representation and participation; General WHS risk and workplace management; Hazardous work; Plant and structures; Construction work; Hazardous chemicals (GHS video); Asbestos; Ch 11 General; and Ch 10 Mines and Sch 26 and 27 (70% of the training).

Venue and course duration: TNLC East Perth training room, 8 hour course (8 am to 4 pm). Class size will be limited to 10 (min of 6 required).

Cost: \$350 includes course notes and regulations, all day coffee, morning tea and lunch.

Training dates - WHS(Mines)R 2022 Awareness Training:

April 2022: Monday 11th, Tuesday 19th and Friday 22th
May 2022: Monday 9th, Tuesday 10th and Friday 27th

The beneficial outcomes of this approach and the training are:

- A more aware and better prepared operational staff and the flow-on effect to the workforce resulting in improved WHS performance in the workplace.
- The staged approach can adapt to the new WHS legislative regime as clarity emerges (as uncertainty reduces).
- Statutory position candidates will have clear understanding of the legislative context in which their examination takes place (Stages 1 and 2).
- All statutory position candidates will be well prepared - using position customised training materials, study and exam techniques - to take their examination (Stage 3).
